Our Coming Together

The COVID-19 crisis has shown us more than ever before just how critical local health care is in America. Nearly every community in the U.S. developed its own approach to the pandemic, from public health messaging, to mask policies, testing sites, field clinics, and vaccine distribution. Incredible learnings emerged along with new health care leaders and new ways of building community health.

Health Information Exchanges (HIEs)

HIEs provide technology for the secure digital exchange of data by medical, behavioral, and social service providers to improve the health of the communities they serve. HIEs can be statewide, regional and community; government-run, for-profit and nonprofit; large and small; and hybrids that involve collaborations among diverse organizations.

Regional Health Improvement Collaboratives (RHICs)

A RHIC provides a neutral, trusted mechanism through which the community can plan, facilitate, and coordinate the many different activities required for successful transformation of its health care system. A RHIC does not deliver healthcare services directly or pay for such services.





Advocacy Update

- Civitas works with an expert Government Relations Team across two firms –
 Troutman Pepper Strategies and Alston & Bird.
- Civitas advocacy strategy is in development bringing legacy SHIEC and NRHI members and interests together.
- Advocacy two-pager and supporting introduction slides in development for future meetings.
- Civitas is also a member of the National Alliance to Impact the Social Determinants
 of Health on behalf of our members.



TPS and A&B – Advocacy Priorities

- House E&C Member-Led Bipartisan Letter to GAO on HIEs
 - GAO confirmed they will take on report 7 months
 - Reps. DeGette, Eshoo, Guthrie, Burgess signed
- SHIEC Cost Allocation Letter
 - Sent to CMS, OMB, White House, and congressional leadership
 - Requesting congressional briefing from CMS/OMB
- SHIEC Annual Conference August 15-18, 2021
 - Coordinated Reps. Upton & DeGette & Lisa Bari discussion CURES 1.0 & 2.0
 - Coordinated Senior Hill Staff panel Questions from SHIEC Members
 - Assisted with keynote speaker Mariann Yeager, RCE update with ONC
- Partnered with NASDOH to support their RFI response to the Congressional SDOH Caucus
- HITAC Appointment, Lisa Bari pending, multiple letters of support
- Meetings with CMS and other Admin/WH Officials pending
- Meetings with Civitas Members and congressional offices pending



ONC HIE Data Visualization Dashboard Update

- Onboarding for the HIE Data Visualization Dashboard closes October 31
 - Milestone #1 Send in the Subcontractor Agreement and Business Associate Agreement
 - Milestone #2 Set up sFTP for weekly COVID-19 lab and vaccine data submission*
 - Milestone #3 Contribute to the public health use cases development for the Final Report
- Public Health Use Case Development: (November January)
 - Complete survey form (November)
 - Submit information for priority public health use cases for your state region (summaries, users, technical approaches, required standards, requirements, challenges, policies)
 - Identify point of contact to join the working sessions, documenting, and editing of public health use cases
 - Participate in working sessions (November December)
 - Sign up for working sessions (sign ups available by October 22)
 - Join scheduled, small group working sessions to confirm the information
 - Finalize Public Health Use Cases for Final Report (January 2022)
 - Review, validate, and provide edits for final use case documentation

Open Civitas Councils and Workgroups

Social Determinants of Health and Interoperability Workgroup	The SDoH and Interoperability Workgroup is responsible for gaining insight into, and providing members resources about, emerging community initiatives focused on SDoH data, interoperability, social care platforms, and community referrals and partnerships.
Marketing and Communications Workgroup	The Marketing and Communications Workgroup is responsible for sharing best practices, researching, collecting, developing, reviewing and distributing marketing, communications, and participant engagement for Civitas and its member organizations.
Quality and Payer Workgroup	The Quality and Payer Workgroup shares best practices and guidance for Civitas members on payer/health plan and related quality improvement topics and partnerships.
Annual Conference Planning Workgroup	The Annual Conference Planning Workgroup leads the event design and content selection process for the conference, identifies key partners and local hosts, and represents the Civitas membership throughout the entire planning process.
Standards and Technology Operations Workgroup	The Standards and Technology Workgroup addresses information exchange and health care data standards issues, as well as other HIE and RHIC technology topics of interest and/or concerns. It also creates opportunities for discussion and collaboration with subject matter experts in the Civitas community.
Digital Measures and Measurement Workgroup	The Digital Measures Workgroup provides a forum for shared learning and action for HIEs and RHICs involved in digital measures and measurement.
Business Strategy and Operations Workgroup **Full and Affiliate Members only**	The Business Strategy and Operations Workgroup brings together executive leaders to collaborate on innovative business practices, sustainability approaches, and tools and resources necessary for maintaining successful organizations.
Advocacy and Government Relations Council **Full and Affiliate Members only**	The Advocacy and Government Relations Council is responsible for developing, participating in, and overseeing the execution of Civitas' Public Policy Agenda, identifying opportunities to offer formal comments or informal input on federal legislative or regulatory activity and assisting in the development of comments and input.
Emerging Leaders Council **Full and Affiliate Members only**	The Emerging Leaders Council (ELC) contributes strategic thought leadership for identified Civitas projects and events while also offering a forum for participants to increase understanding and application of critical leaderships skills. Each full and affiliate member of Civitas can appoint a rising leader from their team.

A modern platform built to address the biggest pain points of communications teams, Cerkl is an email marketing and content tool equipped with AI to save time and improve subscriber engagement.

 The Johns Hopkins ACG System: Population/Patient Case-Mix and Predictive Modeling System

The Johns Hopkins ACG Risk Adjuster models and predicts an individuals' health over time, using existing data from medical claims, electronic medical records, and demographics like age and gender.
