

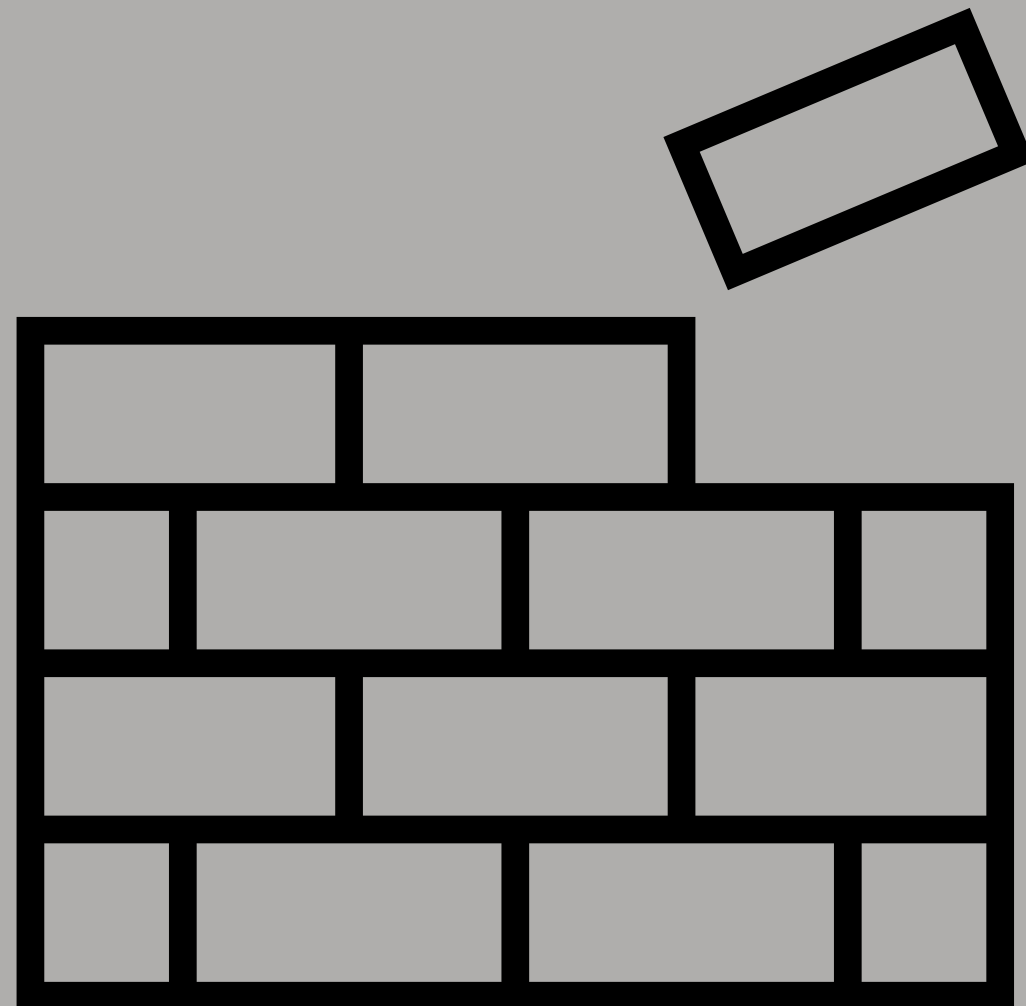
Members, lawmakers, government agencies, peer organizations, and other influencers believe we are an important voice and that our national network fills a critical gap.

- Influential Voice

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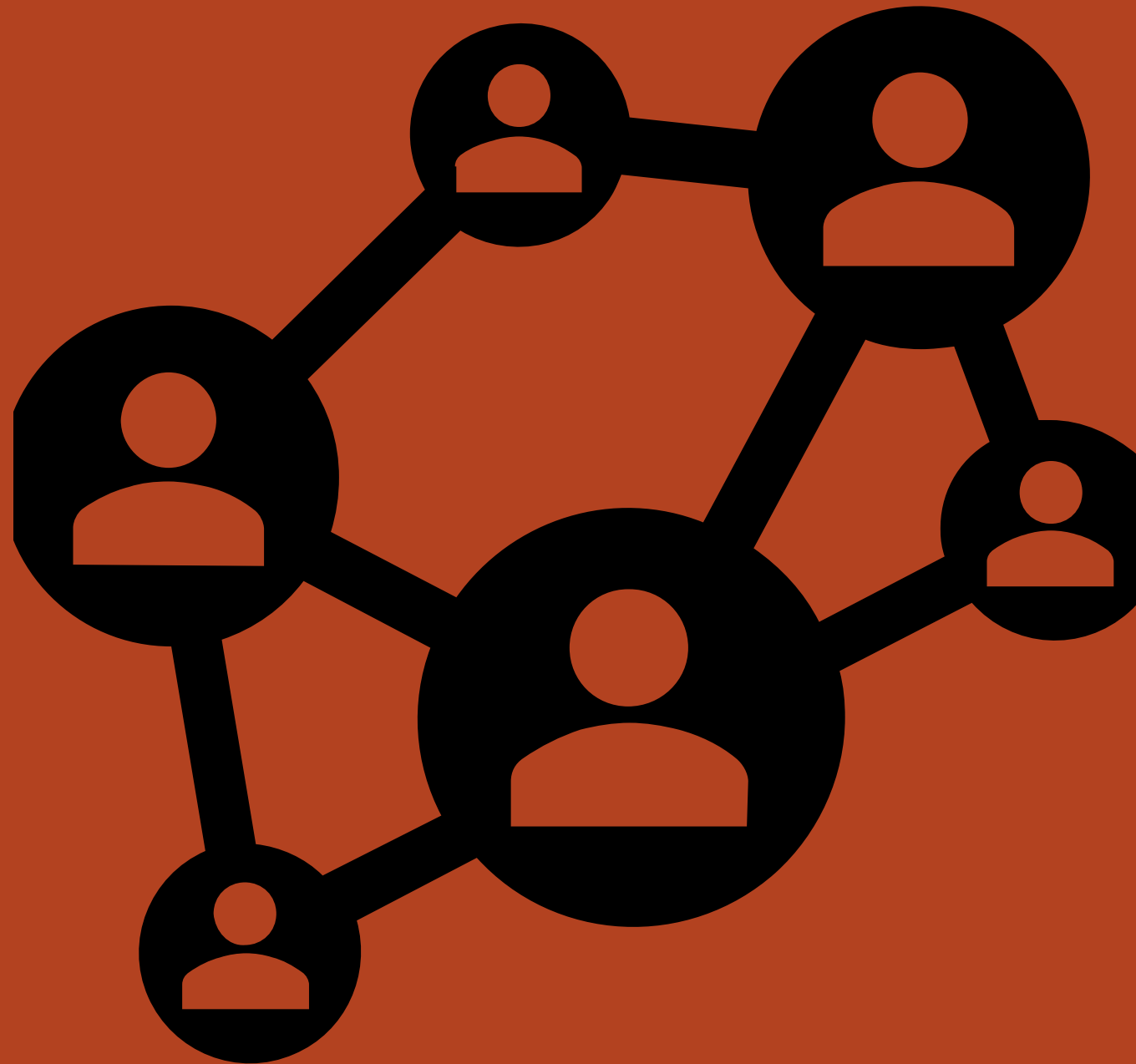
# HIGH LEVEL GOALS – STRONG ORGANIZATION

- Develop new grant funded programs directly aligned with our members' core capabilities and key areas of focus



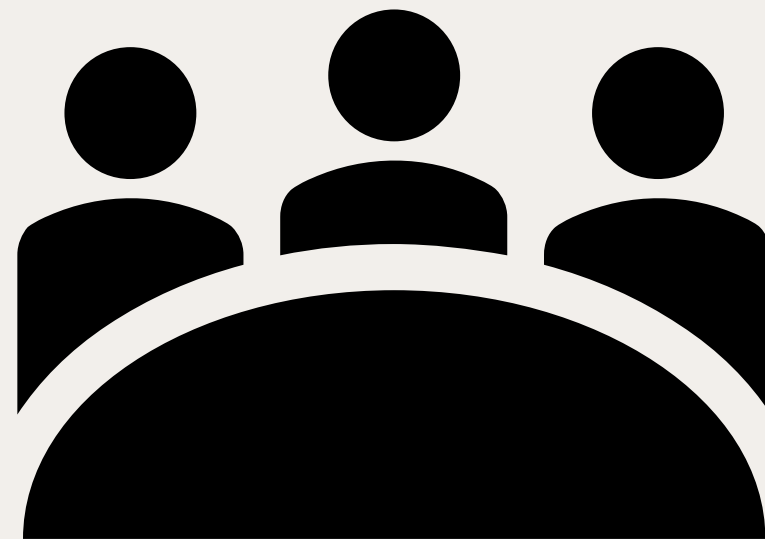


# HIGH LEVEL GOALS – INFLUENTIAL VOICE
