



- AcademyHealth appointed Dr. Aaron Carroll, M.D., M.S., as the organization's new President and CEO.
- CareQuest Institute for Oral Health will be hosting a webinar focused on public health and health equity: Examining History, Shaping the Future Elevating Black Voices in Oral Health Care February 22, 2024, 1-2 p.m. ET.
- Connecting for Better Health launched California's first community-focused virtual testing environment for health and social data exchange. This sandbox will enable health and social service providers and payers to securely and rapidly test, collaborate, and scale, advancing compliance and innovation.
- CyncHealth, in partnership with the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services, was awarded a five-year renewable contract through the CDC Overdose Data to Action for States grant.
- <u>eHealth Exchange</u> launched an incentive program to attract additional early adopters who are willing to participate in the exchange of public health data.


MEMBER NEWS


As we enter 2024, we are building from a strong foundation!

- Influential Voice






HIGH LEVEL GOALS – STRONG ORGANIZATION

- Retain and grow the Civitas team while building a culture of diversity, equity, and inclusion






HIGH LEVEL GOALS – THRIVING NETWORK

- Develop new grant funded programs directly aligned with our members' core capabilities and key areas of focus






HIGH LEVEL GOALS – INFLUENTIAL VOICE
